IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE Authorizing Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land in Augusta to City of Augusta.

Land conveyed to city of Augusta. Resolved: That the Forest Commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to the city of Augusta, land described as follows:

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the west side of the river in Augusta, county of Kennebec and State of Maine, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the easterly line of Jackson Street and said point being one hundred fifty five feet (155') northerly of the stone monument at the northwest corner of the lot of Francis S. Harwood as recorded in Book 738 page 325 in Kennebec Registry of Deeds; thence easterly to a point on the westerly line of Grove Street and said point being one hundred sixty feet (160') northerly of the stone monument at the northeast corner of lot of Eva McAuley. The above described line being the southerly line of said street and the street is forty feet (40') wide northerly of the above described line.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land forty feet (40') wide between Jackson Street and Grove Street and being two hundred thirty feet (230') long more or less.
