STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Service Retirement for State Liquor Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 6, sub-§ IV, ¶A, sub-¶3, additional. Paragraph A of subsection IV of section 6 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subparagraph 3, as follows:

'3. Was a member on July 1, 1947 and is a State Liquor Inspector including the Chief Inspector thereof, excepting those inspectors who are members on the effective date of this addition and who cannot obtain 25 years as a member prior to attainment of age 55 shall be entitled to all the other rights and benefits as provided by this chapter.'
