COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 759, L. D. 1073, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Fishing and Hunting Licenses for
Civilian Employees Residing on Loring Air Base."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the last 3 words and inserting in place thereof the following words: 'Federal Military Bases'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the 3rd blocked paragraph from the end and inserting in place thereof the following underlined blocked paragraph:

ixil-A. A license to hunt or fish shall be issued, at the resident license fee, to any civilian employee and immediate family, residing on said bases. Said civilian employee and immediate family, desiring a hunting or fishing license, must present certification from the commander of said bases or his designated agent, that the person mentioned in the certification is such a civilian employee and immediate family, residing on said bases for a period of 3 months.
