STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Reporter of Decisions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 104, § 1, amended. Section I of chapter 104 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 1. Reporter; appointment and tenure of office; salary. The Governor with the advice and consent of the Council shall, in case of a vacancy, appoint a person learned in the law to be Reporter of the Decisions of the Law Court, who shall hold his office during the pleasure of the Executive. He shall receive an annual salary of \$2,500 \$3,000.'
