IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Alternative Jail Sentences in Default of Payment of Fines or Costs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 149, § 1, amended. Section 1 of Chapter 149 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, as follows:

'Whenever the Court imposes a fine or a fine and costs, the Court shall also impose an alternative jail sentence to be served in default of payment of the fine or fine and costs.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 149, § 42, repealed. Section 42 of chapter 149 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed.
