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### **AN ACT Relating to Alternative Jail Sentences in Default of Payment of Fines or Costs.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 149, § 1, amended.** Section 1 of Chapter 149 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, as follows:

**'Whenever the Court imposes a fine or a fine and costs, the Court shall also impose an alternative jail sentence to be served in default of payment of the fine or fine and costs.'**

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 149, § 42, repealed.** Section 42 of chapter 149 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed.
