STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Designating "The Squire Rangeley Trail."

"The Squire Rangeley Trail"; designated. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission shall be, and hereby is, authorized and instructed to designate as "The Squire Rangeley Trail" that part of the highways beginning at Kittery end of Memorial Bridge between Portsmouth, Route U. S. 4 to be continued as U. S. 4 from Kittery, over Route 103 through Eliot to South Berwick, North Berwick, Sanford, Alfred, Hollis, thence over Route 35 to Bonnie Eagle, Standish, over and cancelling 115 to Gray, Junction U. S. 202 to Junction 122, thence over Old Hotel Road to West Auburn, North Auburn to Route 4 North Turner, Livermore, Livermore Falls, Jay, Wilton, West Farmington to join Route 4 west side near Fairbanks Bridge, Strong, Phillips, Madrid, Sandy River Plantation, Rangeley Plantation and Rangeley.
