SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 781, L. D. 1114, Bill, "An Act Relating to Disqualifications for Benefits Under Employment Security Law."

Amend said Bill in the 20th line by striking out the period after the underlined word "work" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words and punctuation:

'and no work which would have been considered suitable at the time of his registration has been offered to him after the beginning of such illness or disability. The claimant shall furnish satisfactory evidence of such illness or disability in such form as the Commission shall prescribe.'
