STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Legal Voters in York Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1929, c. 8, § 9-A, additional. Chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1929 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 9-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 9-A. "Legal voters within said district," defined. For the purposes of this act "legal voters within said district" shall mean the legal voters of the town of York residing within said territorial limits of said district and the legal voters of the town of York who are rate paying users of water outside the territorial limits of said district.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1929, c. 8, § 18, amended. Section 18 of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1929 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 18. Selectmen of York prepare list of voters; warrants for election. In all elections hereunder the selectmen of the town of York shall exclude from their lists and from all check lists the legal voters who are resident outside the territorial limits of said water district not "legal voters within said district" as defined in this act, and all warrants issued for elections shall be varied accordingly to show that only the voters resident within the territorial limits of said water district are entitled to vote hereunder.'
