### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to State Owned Automobiles for Liquor Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 30, amended. The first sentence of section 30 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The State shall provide no automobiles for travel of employees. ; provided, however, that this This shall not apply to the Governor, the State Police, State Liquor Inspectors, Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries, inspectors in the Motor Vehicle Division of the Secretary of State, supervisors in the Maine Forestry District, Highway Department nor to such heads of departments or members of commissions as the Governor and Council may from time to time designate.'
