STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Removal of Persons from Indian Tribal Reservations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 349, amended. The 4th sentence of section 349 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'After due hearing, said judge may if he is satisfied that such removal is approved by the majority of the adult members of said tribe or is for any cause proper to be enforced order the respondent to remove within a specified time beyond the tribal reservation limits.'
