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

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Repealing Obsolete Indian Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, §§ 325-328, 330-333, 347, 362, 364, 365, 368, repealed. Sections 325 to 328, inclusive, sections 330 to 333, inclusive, sections 347, 362, 364, 365 and 368, all of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, are hereby repealed.
