RESOLVE, Authorizing Research of Cystic Fibrosis, a Disease of Children.

Research of cystic fibrosis; authorized. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Welfare be, and hereby is, authorized to study cystic fibrosis, a deadly disease which attacks children and to begin any necessary research and treatment with the end to attempt to find a cure for this disease; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958 and \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959 to carry out the purposes of this resolve. Such appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Cystic fibrosis is a deadly disease which attacks children through the pancreas. The purpose of this resolve is to make an effort to treat and find a cure for this disease.
