**RESOLVE, Designating East Deering Expressway as Charles J. Loring, Jr.
Memorial Highway.**

East Deering Expressway; designated. Resolved: That in commemoration of the highly meritorious and selfless service of the late Charles J. Loring, Jr., of Portland, Major in the United States Air Force, rendered in the defense of his country during World War II, for which he made the supreme sacrifice and was awarded posthumously the Congressional Medal of Honor that the East Deering Expressway be named the "Charles J. Loring, Jr. Memorial Highway" and that appropriate markers designating the name of the expressway be erected at appropriate intervals along said expressway by the State Highway Commission.
