**RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Aurore Auclair of Lewiston.**

---

**Aurore Auclair; state pension. Resolved:** That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Aurore Auclair, of Lewiston, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Auclair is 52 years of age and paralyzed. He has no relatives to support him.
