#### **RESOLVE, Relating to Sponsorship of Annual Conference of Auditors, Controllers and Treasurers.**

---

**Funds for entertaining annual conference of State Auditors, Controllers and Treasurers; appropriated. Resolved:** That the sum of \$6,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to provide for holding the annual conference of State Auditors, Controllers and Treasurers in Maine; and be it further

**Resolved:** That such sum shall be appropriated to the Treasurer of State and shall be expended on recommendation of a committee composed of the State Auditor, State Controller and the Treasurer of State; and be it further

**Resolved:** That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been completed.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The national conference of the Association of State Auditors, Controllers and Treasurers, since inception, has been held annually in most of the several states which have provided necessary funds to sponsor said conference. The conference has not been held in this State though the State Auditor, State Controller and Treasurer of State are members of the Association and attend and participate in these conferences. Properly, the State of Maine should reciprocate these courtesies by appropriating the necessary funds to entertain this conference in Maine.
