STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, for Construction of Route No. 186, Hancock County.

Construction of Route No. 186; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958 to be expended under the supervision of the State Highway Commission for the construction of Route No. 186, beginning at junction with U. S. Route No. 1 in Gouldsboro, Hancock county, and continuing towards Winter Harbor; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This section of road is one of the old roads with very little work done in recent years. It is also an access road to the Naval Station and has considerable traffic using it. The U. S. Government will build a housing development for the Navy personnel at the Naval Station in the very near future, which will increase traffic over this road materially. Five miles of Route 186 was supposed to have been built under the Accelerated Highway Program of several years ago for which a \$27,000,000 bond issue was made, but the work was never done.
