STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Aldermen of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. V, § 9, amended. Section 9 of Article V of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as last amended by chapter 187 of the private and special laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. g. Compensation. The members of the board of aldermen shall receive as full compensation for the performance of their official duties as aldermen the sum of \$15 for each meeting of the city council which they shall attend provided that no alderman shall be paid an amount in excess of \$500 **\$700** for such attendance during any one fiscal year. Members of the board of aldermen when they shall convene for the purpose of constituting a board of examiners in insanity cases shall receive as full compensation for such duties the sum of \$5 for each meeting attended.'
