SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 821, L. D. 1164, Bill, "An Act to

Exclude Town of Cooper, Washington County, from Maine Forestry District."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title: 'An Act Relating to the Maine Forestry District.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 36, §96, amended. The 1st sentence of section 96 of chapter 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 13 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

A tax of \$ 3/4 mills on the dollar is assessed upon all the property in the Maine Forestry District, including rights in public reserved lots, to be used for the protection thereof; except that in organized municipalities the tax rate shall be \$ 3/4 mills multiplied by a Traction whose numerator is the previous year's assessed value of the land taxable by the municipality, including dams and power houses but not including any other structure or building, and whose denominator shall be the total previous year's assessed value of all property taxable by the municipality.
