STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Samuel Hanson of Baring.

Samuel Hanson; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Samuel Hanson, of Baring, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Samuel Hanson is 86 years of age and nearly blind. He is not eligible for Old Age Assistance because the Department of Health and Welfare claim he has a son able to support him. Mr. Hanson claims this person is not his son. He lives in the home of this person but receives only the barest necessities. This pension would enable Mr. Hanson to live respectably. He has been offered the opportunity to go to the Jefferson Home but does not wish to leave his lifetime home.
