STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Herbert Chase of Burnham.

Herbert Chase; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Herbert Chase, of Burnham, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Chase has many children all of whom need financial help. He has no means of support.
