SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 420, L. D. 1179, Bill, "An Act Creating
the Town of Milbridge School District."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the title and before the
enacting clause the following Emergency Preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, the school buildings which house
the common schools of the town of Milbridge are inadequate and unsafe;
and

Whereas, it is imperative that action be taken at the earliest
possible moment to relieve these conditions; and

Whereas, to remedy these conditions construction must be com-
menced immediately; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create
an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and
require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by striking out the headnote and first
sentence of the Referendum at the end of said Bill and inserting in
place thereof the following:

'Emergency clause; referendum; certificate to Secretary of State.
In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take
effect when approved, only for the purpose of permitting its sub-
mission to the legal voters of the territory embraced within the
limits of said district at a special meeting to be called and held
for the purpose not later than 3 months after the approval of this
act.'
