STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Authorizing Rules and Regulations of Public Utilities Commission for Safety and Health of Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 46, § 63-A, additional. Chapter 46 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 63-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 63-A. Rules and regulations for safety and health of employees. The Public Utilities Commission is hereby authorized to promulgate and enforce reasonable rules and regulations relating to safety, sanitation and adequate shelter as affecting the welfare and health of the Railway Maintenance of Way employees, highway crossing watchmen, station employees and signal employees."
