STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Preference in State Purchases for Products Raised or Manufactured in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 35-A, additional. Chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 35-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 35-A. Preference to products raised or manufactured in Maine. Whereever feasible, all purchases made by the State Purchasing Agent, and all other state agencies and commissions authorized to make purchases, priority shall be given to products, merchandise, supplies and commodities made from the agricultural products of this State, or made, manufactured, assembled, produced or supplied by business or industry in this State.'
