AN ACT Regulating Fishing for Tuna.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 122, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 122 of chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill or have in possession any tuna or horse mackerel, so called, taken by any method other than harpoon or ~~single~~ hook and line within the territorial waters of this State.'
