STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Regulating Fishing for Tuna.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 122, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 122 of chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill or have in possession any tuna or horse mackerel, so called, taken by any method other than harpoon or single hook and line within the territorial waters of this State.'
