AN ACT Relating to Loads on Vehicles Operated on Public Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 96, amended. The last sentence of section 96 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘The word “load” as used in this paragraph shall include, but shall not be limited to, firewood, pulpwood, logs, bolts or other material, but shall not include loose hay, pea vines, straw, grain, cornstalks or poultry waste.’
