STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Designating a Certain Road as "Moosehead Trail."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. "Moosehead Trail," designated. The following described highway is hereby designated as the "Moosehead Trail": Beginning in Belfast at the junction of Route U. S. 1 and Route 3; thence on Route 7 to Newport and Dexter; thence on Route 23 to Sangerville and to the junction of Route 15 in Guilford; thence on Route 15 to Greenville and Jackman, ending at the junction of Route 15 and U. S. 201.

The State Highway Commission shall erect and maintain suitable signs designating the "Moosehead Trail."

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1951 c. 165, § 1, repealed. Section 1 of chapter 165 of the private and special laws of 1951, as amended by chapter 108 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby repealed.
