COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 427, L. D. 1210, Resolve, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Providing for Limited Even-Year Budget Sessions of the Legislature.

Amend said Resolve by striking out the question "Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by resolution of the Legislature Providing for Limited Even-Year Budget Sessions of the Legislature?" and substituting in its stead the following:

"Shall the Constitution be Amended so that beginning with the year 1960 Budget Sessions of not to exceed of thirty calendar days shall be held, commencing on the first Wednesday of January, and each even numbered year thereafter, at which the Legislature shall consider only Appropriation Bills for the succeeding fiscal year, revenue bills necessary therefor, and such acts and resolves, resolutions or motions as may be necessary to provide for the expense and conduct of the Budget Session, as proposed by a Resolution of the Legislature?"

Reported by a Minority of the Committee on Constitutional Amendments.

Read and adopted in the Senate May 16, 1957.
