STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Daniel McCurdy of Weeks Mills.

Daniel McCurdy; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$60 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Daniel McCurdy, of Weeks Mills, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of chapter 194 of the resolves of 1949 which provides for a state pension for Daniel McCurdy, of Weeks Mills, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. McCurdy is about 90 years of age and unable to work. He has no one to help support him. Mr. McCurdy is an alien. The increase in pension is asked for because of the increased cost of living.
