RESOLVE, Relating to Taking of Alewives in the Outlet of Long Pond in Town of Mount Desert.

Taking of alewives in outlet of Long pond; regulated. Resolved: That the inhabitants of the town of Mount Desert shall have exclusive rights to the taking of alewives from the waters in the outlet of Long pond in the town of Mount Desert, Hancock county. Said privilege shall not include the taking of alewives within 300 feet of the fishway situate in said outlet; and be it further

Resolved: That said town may, by vote at its annual meeting, provide the times, amounts and manner in which alewives may be taken from the waters of said outlet and may likewise provide that municipal licenses or permits be required for such taking and fix the fees thereof.
