#### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Judge and Recorder of the Yorkshire Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1911, c. 279, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 279 of the private and special laws of 1911, as last amended by chapter 144 of the private and special laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 15. Salary of judge and recorder. The judge shall receive a salary in full for all services of \$1,500 \$2,500 per year to be paid him by the county of York, and the recorder a salary of \$1,800 per year, payable quarterly.'
