IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Qualifications of Judge of Brunswick Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1903, c. 277, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 277 of the private and special laws of 1903 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. r. Brunswick municipal court established. A municipal court is hereby established in and for the town of Brunswick, in the county of Cumberland, which shall be called the municipal court for the town of Brunswick; and said court shall consist of one judge, a citizen of said town and a duly qualified attorney at law, who shall be appointed by the Governor, with the consent of the Council, and who shall be duly sworn.'
