**AN ACT Authorizing Forest Commissioner to Convey Interest of the State in
Jaquish Island, Cumberland County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Forest Commissioner authorized to convey Jaquish Island. The State Forest Commissioner is authorized to convey by sale to the highest bidder, for a sum not less than \$500, the interest of the State in Jaquish Island, adjacent to Bailey Island, in Cumberland County.

Sec. 2. Jaquish Island part of Harpswell. Jaquish Island, which lies adjacent to Bailey Island, in the county of Cumberland, is hereby annexed to and shall become a part of the town of Harpswell.
