STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Permitting Caucus for Penobscot Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 370, amended. Section 370 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding a new paragraph at the end thereof to read as follows:

'On the first Tuesday of August biennially on the even-numbered years the Penobscot Indians shall hold a caucus for the purpose of nominating candidates to be elected as provided in this section.'
