STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Group Life Insurance for Certain Former Members of State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 63-A, § 24, sub-§ I-A, additional. Section 24 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 451 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended by adding a new subsection, to be numbered I-A, to read as follows:
- 'I-A. Notwithstanding any provisions of subsection I, each member of the State Police who was a member of the State Police Retirement System on September 5, 1955 and thereafter retired, shall be eligible for group life insurance, if such member pays into the group life insurance fund for such insurance, the unpaid premiums therefor, for the period September 5, 1955 to the effective date of such retirement.'
