# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

### An Act Relating to Fees of Registers of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 216, amended. The 1st, 2nd and 5th paragraphs of section 216 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes are hereby amended to read as follows:

'Recording a deed or mortgage that fits the printed form currently in use in the registry, \$1.50 \$3; recording a quitclaim deed, \$2.50.

Recording an assignment or discharge of mortgage, discharge of attachment, discharge of inheritance tax or discharge of a municipal tax lien in the usual short form, \$1 \$2.

Receiving and filing a certificate of election of a clerk of a corporation, resignation of such clerk, or certificate of change of name or change of location of a corporation, <del>\$1</del> \$2.

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 89, § 216, amended. Section 216 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended, by adding 3 new paragraphs following the 11th paragraph, to read as follows:

'Recording a power of attorney, mortgage foreclosure, consent, agreement, decree, notice, confirmation, bill of sale or bond for deed, \$3.

Recording a right, contract, par release, petition or affidavit, \$2.

Recording a devise, \$1.50; a lease, \$3.50; a waiver, \$3.50.'
