Everett L. Scott; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of \$196.75 to be paid to Everett L. Scott, of Calais, a licensed funeral director and embalmer, for a complete funeral service and embalming of Beldin A. Yates, an indigent person, of Grand Lake Stream Plantation, Maine, on May 24, 1953.
