# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

### AN ACT Relating to Automobile Travel by State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 31, amended. The 1st sentence of section 31 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The State shall pay for the use of privately owned automobiles for travel by employees of the State in the business of the State not more than 7e 9c per mile for the first 5,000 miles actually travelled by such employees on such business in any one fiscal year, and 6e 7c for each mile exceeding 5,000 miles; provided, however, that the The State shall pay inspectors of seed potatoes 8e 9c for every mile so travelled.'
