IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, For Construction of a Certain Road in Knox County.

Construction of certain road in Knox county; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958 to be expended under the supervision of the State Highway Commission for the construction of a road leading directly from State Aid Road No. 4 to the Alford flat road designated as State Aid Road No. 2; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Due to the consolidation of Hope schools, the pupils at South Hope will have to be transported to Hope Corner and this road is one which would have to be used to pick up several pupils. If it cannot be used the bus route would have to go through Union which would greatly increase mileage.
