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

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Revoking License of Operator of Motor Vehicle Used in Commission of a Felony.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 6-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 6-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 6-A. Operator of motor vehicle used in commission of a felony. The Secretary of State may revoke the license of any driver, when such driver has been finally convicted of any felony in the commission of which a motor vehicle is used.'
