STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Exempting Motor Vehicles of Military Personnel in Maine from Excise Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 49, amended. Section 49 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 100 and by section 11 of chapter 200 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended by adding a new paragraph at the end thereof to read as follows:

'No member of the armed forces of the United States who is stationed at some military or naval post, station or base within the State shall be required to pay the annual excise tax for any automobile owned by him.'
