STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Lobster Meat Received from Outside the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 116, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 116 of chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following paragraph enacted in place thereof:

'It shall be lawful for holders of a wholesale sea food dealer's and processor's license to receive meat from other states and countries providing such meat is processed by canning or freezing, for resale as processed stews, newburgs, chowders or pies, in the retail trade. Such meat shall not be resold unless so processed and it must conform to the provisions of section 116. The purchaser of such meat is required to file a monthly statement of such shipments received with the Commissioner on forms furnished by the Commissioner and the shipping containers cannot be opened until immediately prior to processing of the meat.'

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
