AN ACT Relating to Service Retirement Credits for Teachers Employed by Veterans Administration.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 1, amended. The next to the last paragraph of section 1 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof 2 new sentences, to read as follows:

'The term "teacher" shall also mean any teacher employed as a teacher by the Veterans Administration at any facility operated by said Veterans Administration in this State or out of state subsequent to World War II. Such teacher shall not be entitled to receive any retirement benefits for such service if eligible for retirement benefits therefor under any federal retirement system.'
