STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Fortnightly Payment of Salaries and Wages to State Officers and Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 29, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 29 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘State officers and employees normally considered as salaried employees shall be paid their salaries fortnightly, the dates of payment to be determined by the State Controller. Payment may be made once in each calendar month to such state officers and employees as consent to such time of payment.

Others employees normally considered as employed in a labor division shall be paid their wages weekly. In instances when salaried employees' names usually appear on labor payrolls, payments may be made on a weekly basis for practical reasons. Temporary and seasonal employees of the State shall be paid at such time as the Commissioner of Finance and Administration shall specify.’
