HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 937, L. D. 1330, Bill, "An Act to

Discontinue Fort Kent State Normal School and to Use the

Buildings for Other Educational Purposes."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the word "Purposes" in the Title the following words 'and to Discontinue Washington State Teachers' College at Machias'

Further amend said Bill by drawing a line through the words ", the Washington State Teachers! College at Machias" in the 5th and 6th lines as follows: ',-the-Washington-State-Teachers!-Gellege at-Machias!

Further amend said Bill by adding a new section to follow "Sec. 1." to read as follows:

"Sec. 1-A. R. S., c. 41, §230-A, additional. Chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 230-A, to read as follows:

Scholarships for teacher training. The State Board of Education shall, by competitive scholarship examination. award scholarships each year to students residing in Washington County and in towns in the St. Johns Valley, not to exceed 200 such scholarships per year. Such scholarships shall not exceed \$500 per year per student for attendance at any State Teachers' College or the University of Maine for teacher training. The standards for such scholarships shall be determined by the State Board of Education. Students attending the Fort Kent State Normal School at Fort Kent and the Washington State Teachers' College at Machias for the school year 1956-57 shall automatically be eligible for the scholarships provided by this section."

Further amend said Bill by striking out "Sec. 4." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. Any sums which may be appropriated by the Legislature for the fiscal years 1957-58 and 1958-59 for Fort Kent State Normal School at Fort Kent and the Washington State Teachers' College at Machias shall be appropriated to the Department of Education for the scholarships provided by section 230-A of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes.'
