## STATE OF MAINE

**AN ACT Relating to False Report of Deposit of Bombs or Other Infernal Devices.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 130, § 22-A, additional.** Chapter 130 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 22-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 22-A. False report as to bomb. Whoever calls out or causes to be called out any fire department, police department or other municipal department, or any portion or persons thereof, by intentionally giving a false report as to the deposit of any bomb or infernal machine in any public place, knowing such report to be false, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or by both.’
