STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Equity Suit after Period of Redemption in the Collection of Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91-A, § 92, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 92 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new sentence to read as follows:

'Such suit in equity may be maintained by any subsequent grantee of said town relying upon the title of said town.'
