STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Bail Provisions in Prosecutions Under Liquor Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 71, amended. The last 3 sentences of section 71 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes are hereby repealed, as follows:

'In appeals from any judgment or sentence before such court or magistrate, the penal sum in every recognizance shall be not less than \$500. No recognizance, before such court or magistrate, shall be in a sum less than \$500. In no ease shall the penal sum of the recognizance be reduced after being fixed by the court.'
