STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Costs in Actions on Small Claims.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 109, § 3, amended. The last sentence of section 3 of chapter 109 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The plaintiff or his authorized attorney shall at the same time pay an entry fee of \$2 \$3.'

- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 109, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 109 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- **'Sec. 4. Fees.** Of the amount of the entry fee, the judge shall receive 75e \$1. Of the \$1.25 \$2.25 remaining a sufficient sum shall be applied directly on the registered or certified postage mentioned in section 6 and the balance shall be retained by the clerk or recorder, or in towns where there is no clerk or recorder, by the judge in addition to the 75e \$1 fee mentioned above.'
- Sec. 3. R.S., c. 109, § 5, repealed. Section 5 of chapter 109 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed, as follows:
- 'See. 5. Limitation of number of claims. No person shall be permitted to enter in any one court more than 5 small claims in any one week nor more than 20 small claims in any one month.'
